

Around sixty women participated in the Women In BIO-RTP Professional Development program on May 31, 2012 at the NC Biotechnology Center. Dr. Kim Mayer from the Small business and Technology Development Center of Raleigh kicked off the event by demystifying the process of starting a company. While the focus was largely on creation of a life sciences company, the presentation was applicable to start-ups in most industries. A panel discussion on running companies from C-level executives included Sheila Mikhail from Life Science Law, Dr. Amanda Elam of Galaxy Diagnostics, Prathima Acharya of KBI BioPharma, Karen Adams from KJA Associates and moderator Claudia Black of G-Zero Therapeutics. A broad range of topics were covered involving operations, management, mentorship, finance and alignment of values. The

importance of sense of humor while dealing with difficult situations was highlighted.

Katie Trapp of the NC Biotechnology Center navigated the do's and don'ts of social media and presented best practices to developing a digital persona.
